
Why I launched this festival

During the pandemic I saw a need: cello students in Latin America became more isolated, uninspired, and disconnected. Musical activities halted and many were left without their supportive teachers, who had to leave due to political reasons or the economic climate. Even before the pandemic, these highly talented cellists had very limited resources to reach their full potential.

I knew that with my ability to bridge cultures, I could curate a transformative experience to support young cellists at a very challenging time, help them regain their energy, and acquire the experience they need to further their careers.

What is the Cellisimo Festival?

The Cellisimo Festival is a two-week, intensive virtual program for advanced Spanish speaking cellists, ages 15-24, who are interested in or currently pursuing a career in music. All sessions are in Spanish.

The festival focuses on high level cello learning, mental health wellness and creating a tight-knit community.

The festival also includes sessions which are open to donors and members of the Cellisimo Facebook Group.

What need does it fill?

Music students all over the world have felt deeply isolated during the pandemic and many have still not regained access to their regular musical activities.

Even pre-pandemic, Latin American students faced these challenges. Despite being highly talented and surmounting obstacles to pursue a classical music career, many lack the resources to attend the educational programs they NEED in order to reach their full potential and build a sustainable career.

Classical musicians' success depends on a training beyond private lessons: masterclasses with international soloists and master teachers, festival participation, mentor and peer connections, audition coaching, and more.

Students also desperately need support, now more than ever, with mental and physical wellbeing in order to achieve long-term success.

The festival is here to address all these needs.



Empowering leadership in young musicians

Festival participants are highly talented young musicians who are forging a path in classical music in their respective countries, despite many obstacles. The festival empowers them with a supportive international community of peers and mentors, as well as a set of highly effective tools for personal and career development.

Inspiration - the driving force for success

The most powerful motivator in classical music career development is listening to peers or a master musician. The festival allows access both to a highly select group of peers, as well as world renowned musicians -- facilitating transformative experiences that will fuel participants' drive to practice more and achieve greatness in the field.

Life-changing connections

Musicians depend heavily on connections in their career. Auditions and job success is dependant not only on excellence in playing, but also on working with prominent teachers and participating in festivals and masterclasses. The festival gives participants life-long connections with peers and faculty beyond their borders.

Cultivating positive mental health

The music field is highly competitive and the striving for excellence can bring on feelings of inadequacy, stress and anxiety. These challenges have only grown during the pandemic. The festival makes space for participants to voice their struggles, and also provides guidance, tools and strategies for musicians' positive mental and physical health.

What makes Cellisimo unique?

PROGRAM COMPONENTS & SELECTION PROCESS

Private lessons

Students receive 2 private lessons, where they delve deeply into their repertoire in a 1:1 setting. Students can attend each other's lessons to maximize learning.

Group Technique Class

Every day, students come together for a group technique class, where key aspects of achieving high level technique are addressed.

Masterclasses and Special Sessions

Students have the opportunity to play in masterclassess for world renowned musicians. In addition, the festival offers lectures and special sessions about improvisation, early baroque practice, pedagogy, career guidance, audience engagement, and more.

Wellness sessions

Daily wellness sessions include yoga, meditation, mindfulness, journaling, and fitness for musicians.

What does each student receive?

How are the participants selected?

Musicians are used to being selected solely based on their playing. At the Cellisimo Festival, we follow a different process.

As Artistic Director, I begin the selection process by reviewing the applicants' videos LAST. I look at their musical education, how dedicated they are to their studies, and their past musical experiences. I then move on to their essays, which offer a window into their most important musical experience and obstacles they have faced. First, I take in their story. Only then, I listen to their videos.

This process enables me to see the whole musician — their talent and musical potential, as well as their leadership skills and commitment to community building. This admissions approach yielded an incredible cohort in 2021. The participants bonded instantly, inspired each other musically and personally, and created one of the most meaningful communities I've had the pleasure of convening.
